Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

July 8, 2020, 7:30 p.m.

Meeting Called to Order at approximately 7:31 PM, July 8, 2020.

Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting(s)

Secretary Rodriguez reported that the Minutes of the June Executive Committee Meeting were not yet complete.

Regional Executive's Report

Regional Executive Bob Hudson reported that Director Shanna Richardson had volunteered to chair the Membership Committee. Hudson requested that the other Directors and Chairs seek out members to assist Shanna with the Membership Committee.

RE Hudson then reported on the unexpected death of Timing and Scoring Chief Jenny Paradis, and the associated response to address the loss of a valuable contributor to the Region's success. RE Hudson reported that Director Dave Rollow was working to retrieve our equipment from Paradis' mother. RE Hudson also reported that Anna Crissman and Rich Mesick will be at the Summer Sizzle, and would be asked them to bring backup equipment as well. RE Hudson also indicated he has reached out to three other National License holders to ask for their assistance in operating the event.

RE Hudson also reported that the Jumbo Region call scheduled for July 7 had been rescheduled.

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Carol Cone provided an overview of the Region's Finances. It was suggested that the replacements for the Treasurer role (Treasurer and Bookkeeper) be invited to the next Executive Committee meeting.

Department Reports

Solo (Includes Autocross, Starting Line and Street Survival)

Solo Co-Chair Rodriguez reported that our first event Post-COVID had been successful. One volunteer had reported a positive COVID test for a spouse, but the volunteer was subsequently tested and found to be negative. Rodriguez reported on upcoming events and that he would be attending the Solo Town Hall meeting. Director Carol Cone provided an update on the operations at a recent autocross event she attended at Bristol Motor Speedway.

Rallycross

Rallycross Chair Christian Retterer reported that while Rallycross had not yet held an event, there was one scheduled for July 11. Registration was low, and the pace of the season would be dependent on how well the event is actually attended. Retterer reported receiving many inquiries about participation in Rallycross in general.

Retterer reported that he had attended the Ohio Valley Region Nation Tour event, and interest was expressed in using AMS for a future National Tour event. Retterer also reported that the National Rallycross Championship location (Road America) was no longer viable, and that a new venue was being identified.

Time Trials

Chair Dustin Stevenson reported that RE Hudson is looking to make room at ARRC for a time trial event. Stevenson also reported that the Time Trial National Tour was going well, and that the 2020 Tire Rack SCCA Time Trials at Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park had been a successful event on July 4. However, Stevenson also reported that the SEDIV 2020 points for traditional time trials would probably be rolled over to 2021, due to a lack of points events caused by COVID cancellations.

Road Racing (includes Track Events)

Race Chair Pro Tem Hudson reported that we still did not have a signed contract with the track for the July 25-26 Summer Sizzle event. There was also concern about whether or not the event will be allowed to be held or if COVID restrictions or other issue might cause problems. With regard to COVID, supplemental regulations include a provision that masks/face covering would be mandatory, with the only exceptions being in car or in trailer. Otherwise, masks/face coverings would be required at all times. Assistant RE McInnis suggested a Race Board meeting be held the following week. Hudson agreed to set one up.

Road Rally

No Report.

Website (includes Social Media)

Webmaster Randall Prince was not present to report.

Director Dean Richardson reported that our social media presence on Facebook had recently achieved a milestone of having over 3000 followers. Richardson also reported that the first MailChimp newsletter under his authorship had gone out on June 3, and that he was working with RE Hudson on the next issue.

Unfinished Business and General Orders

Update: Membership Committee Charter (Rodriquez)

Secretary Rodriquez reported that he had not yet found a draft charter to send, but would do so and sent it to the new Membership Committee chair (Director Shanna Richardson).

New Business

No new business was introduced.
